

# A MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Happy New Year! This year is going to be very exciting! We anticipate that Phase 2 of our Building Program will be completed in late April/early May. That is going to open a whole new phase of ministry for this church and strengthen existing ministries. We will have the space and opportunity to reach deep into the community and meet some important needs. The vision

that God has placed before us is in "Bringing our BEST to the Community" and that we will seek to serve God and the people in the Troy area in ways that deepen their relationships with Him.

Some of the ways we hear God's call is through healthy ministry to the elderly, to the children and youth, designing a powerful small group ministry and for our church to place a large emphasis on combating hunger. Our Ministry Activity Center – MAC for short – (aka Gym), will be a place for a community Health Fair, providing information and resources for the community, an indoor walking program and exercise, sporting for health events, upwards basketball, after-school opportunities, spring break and summer day and week camps for children, mission teams to have a place to stay while working in the area, expanded youth ministry opportunities, Christian concerts, and much more.

As the staff – both volunteer and paid – work hard to prepare for the physical changes of the facilities over the next few months, we ask that you prayerfully consider where you might be of service. John Wesley, the founder of the United Methodist movement, put social justice and service at the top of what it means to be United Methodist.

One important way we can all focus on what "our individual part" of being part of this body of Christ will mean in 2018 is to attend the JANUARY 28<sup>TH</sup> church-wide conference, led by our Healthy Church Initiative Coach, Rev. Molly Simpson, entitled, "Surviving and Thriving as a Growing Church". This will allow us as a body to understand and move forward in positive ways during our transition in late April/early May. We cannot wait until the building opens, and to transition we have to work ahead of the curve. I am very excited to hear ways we can grow and maintain our distinct character. So, please mark your calendars and plan to join me, the staff, and the persons serving on leadership teams on January 28<sup>th</sup>.


