We all go through struggles in life from divorce to the loss of a loved one and everything in between. Personally, 2017 was a struggle for me and my family. We faced unexpected illness and STEPHEN the loss of my mother all in a 6 month timespan. There were multiple people who helped walk me through that time. They were

there when I needed to talk and reminded me that God loved me and saw me during all of those hard moments. That is exactly what our trained Stephen Ministers do.

So, what is a Stephen Minister? A Stephen Minister comes alongside a hurting person and meets with that person on a regular basis to listen, care, encourage, pray, and provide emotional and spiritual support. Men are paired with men; women with women. Maybe you don't need a Stephen Minister right now but you might know someone who does, a friend, a co-worker, or a family member. This ministry is open to anyone, not just church members. If you need a Stephen Minister or know someone who might, see Pastor Leslie or myself for more information.

From a care receiver at another Stephen Ministry Congregation: "I thank the Lord for my Stephen Minister who did not try to solve all my problems but lovingly, as a Christian brother, walked along with me through this valley in my life."
