"May-kit a Memorable Summer!"

"MAY-KIT A MEMORABLE SUMMER!" by participating in the Fundraiser, "Great Wall of Giving." Last year was our first year for "Great Wall of Giving" and through this fundraiser, we were able instead to host ONE large fundraiser instead of hosting several fundraisers (for both children and youth). Last year, we raised over \$7,000 for youth missions and Glen Lake camperships. Each youth pays for his/her trip cost, but it takes \$700 rental per van, plus gasoline. We need to rent at least 3 more vans besides the two we now own. The children pay for at least half their camp costs (\$375 for the week for room, meals and supplies) and then the church works to offer scholarships for those who cannot afford the other half. We know that CAMP and MISSION TRIPS change lives and enable children and youth to become connected to a family of faith. To donate, all you need to do is to take an envelope, fill out the paper inside and place both the paper and your donation in the envelope – then seal it – and put it in the "Amazing Grace" box on the table. I thank the Lord for my Stephen Minister who did not try to solve all my problems but lovingly, as a Christian brother, walked along with me through this valley in my life. If you are dealing with some type of crisis or difficulty in life, I encourage you to meet with a Stephen Minister. You won't regret it!"
