## **Pastor's Perspective**

In Exodus, Leviticus, and Numbers, the Israelites made a very long pilgrimage through the desert. They carried with them the "tent of meeting" where people could go and worship God. For some periods of time they sat in a place for a while, but following the sitting always came the moving forward on their journey toward the Promised Land. We have been in a period of sitting, resting, and just enjoying getting used to new space and worshiping God since we completed Phase 2, the Ministry Activity Center (MAC). We were coming out of a busy time with lots of changes to prepare us for the next phase.

With January, it is now time to pick up the tent and keep moving forward. We have rested, we have acclimated, and we have seen those things put into place work effectively. Now we are called to move forward. Just like the Israelites, we cannot just sit still or become comfortable – that is when churches move into the bell curve of decline. We have been called to move toward the Promised Land and that means being at work in our community and the world around us in ways that bring others to know of Jesus.

#### **Children Check-In Procedures**

Beginning January 6th, Children's L.Y.F.E. Groups will begin transitioning to a new check in procedure. These procedures are in place in order to ensure every child is provided a safe place to learn, love, and worship.

What you will see is that check in will now be done in the MAC (Ministry Activity Center aka the gym). Parents/Guardians must physically bring their child to be signed in and will then leave their child with the Ministry Safe approved adult managing sign ins that morning. All children will be provided an opportunity to eat donuts and participate in a large group activity before moving to their classrooms with their L.Y.F.E. Group leader.

In the coming months, (hopefully by early February) an electronic check in system will be introduced. We know that there will be kinks and glitches as we figure out what works best to ensure our children's physical and faith needs are met. We ask that you be patient with this process and adhere to the designated process as fully as possible. Your constructive feedback is always appreciated so that we can continue to provide our BEST.

Christin will be available each Sunday morning to help answer questions and guide families during this transition process.
